

What is Global Learning?

Global Learning is a government- funded programme for KS2 and 3, which gives pupils the opportunity to develop their critical thinking in the context global citizenship, linking into themes and schemes of work in your school/college.

Benefits to your school:

- 2. GL meets OFSTED requirements with delivering SMSC and British Values and improves pupil engagement within the themes of rights and responsibilities, justice and peace, one-story perceptions and Eco-schools.
- 3. Just by joining, your school will get £500 e-credits (which can be used to pay for continued professional development courses and training run by third-party providers. These e-credits will be available, once you have completed a whole school audit.
