OBJECTIVE

By distilling the most practical elements of current leadership theory, the programme aims to equip participants with the necessary skills to effectively lead teaching and learning in their own setting. It will enable teachers to reflect on their own traits and current leadership experience as well as how to adapt their leadership style to a range of different contexts. This will be supported by learning how to use coaching to develop others and how to identify and successfully lead change.

By the end of the programme participants will have developed their leadership, managerial and coaching skills, as well as being confident in their ability to impact on school focussed improvements.

The programme has been designed by Middle and Senior Leaders who are experienced in facilitating Middle Leadership learning, in consultation with existing Head Teachers.
